Philis Blood Anderson grew up in Minneapolis in a musical family. Her mother was a concert violinist and her father retired early and became a luthier. Anderson started playing the oboe at the age of 12 and at 15 she soloed with the Minneapolis Symphony (Minnesota Orchestra.) She was awarded musical scholarships from the Schubert Club and Thursday Musical Club and went on to study with John Angelucci, principal oboe of the Minnesota Orchestra. Her accomplishments include playing in the Classical Music Seminar Orchestra in Austria, the Civic Orchestra of Minneapolis, the Bach Society Orchestra of Minneapolis, the Thunder Bay Symphony and the Duluth-Superior Symphony (DSSO) as principal oboist. Anderson has soloed with the DSSO, Cincinnati Conservatory Orchestra, and several orchestras in the Twin Cities. She has performed recitals on the West Coast, the Midwest and Austria. Blood retired from the DSSO in 2000 having played with them for 18 years, she currently resides in Grand Marais.
